

**multiply labelled**

A *selectively labelled* compound may be multiply labelled when in the unmodified compound there is more than one atom of the same element at the position where the isotopic modification occurs, e.g. H in CH<sub>4</sub>, or there are several atoms of the same element at different positions where the isotopic modification occurs, e.g. C in C<sub>4</sub>H<sub>8</sub>O.
